

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Footpath 3,4 & 5, Cold Norton, Footpath 4, Stow Maries and Footpath 11 & 13, Purleigh) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the order: To temporarily close the following length of Footpath 3, 4 & 5, Cold Norton, Footpath 4 Stow Maries and Footpath 11 & 13, Purleigh in the District of Maldon:

Road	Description
Footpath 3, Cold Norton	From its junction with Flambirds Chase, east for approximately 575 metres up to the parish boundary where it becomes Footpath 13, Purleigh.
Footpath 13, Purleigh	From its junction with Footpath 3, Cold Norton, east to its junction with Footpath 14 Purleigh approximately 690 metres.
Footpath 11, Purleigh	From its junction with Flambirds Chase, south to its junction with Footpath 4 Cold Norton approximately 490 metres.
Footpath 4 Cold Norton	From its junction with Footpath 11, Purleigh south for its entire length to its junction with Footpath 5 Cold Norton.
Footpath 5, Cold Norton	From its junction with Footpath 4 Cold Norton to its junction with Footpath 4 Stow Maries approximately 881 metres.
Footpath 4, Stow Maries	From its junction with Footpath 5, Cold Norton east then south to its junction with Footpath 3, Stow Maries for approximately 623 metres.

The alternative route for the above footpath closures will be via: Hackmans Lane, Flambirds Chase, Footpath 3, Stow Maries, Footpath 19, Stow Maries and vice versa.

The temporary closures are scheduled to commence on 26 May, 18 August, 14 & 15 September 2024 between the hours of 08.00 hours and 16:00 hours where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting, are required for the safety of the public while the Fly-in and Air Display at Stow Maries Great War Aerodrome is undertaken.

The Orders will come into effect on 26 May 2024 and may continue in force 6 months or until the event have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
